A STEAM-filled Future

The STEAM Outreach Team continued to promote the mission of the EPSD Education Foundation during a pandemic-challenged 2020 and 2021 by fostering STEAM-related outreach and engagement with the community and by enhancing the relationship between STEAM professionals and educators within the East Penn School District.

The development and launch of the STEAM Outreach Team landing page on the Foundation website in 2019 provided us with a platform for soliciting community volunteers and educator requests. Suggested areas of potential engagement include career speakers, STEAM-related topical talks/presentations, ask-a-scientist/virtual-in-residence activities, invention/innovation talks, technology demonstrations, etc. With this platform — coupled with posts on social media, emails, and personal contact between the members of the Foundation and the community — we were able to build a diverse set of 60+ professionals (spread out across S-T-E-A-M and community service) who were willing to devote their time to helping EPSD educators with their classroom lessons and with school-sponsored career events. In terms of connecting professionals to the classroom, the Team reached out to educators through multiple emails and one-on-one conversations to advertise this valuable resource and to encourage making community resource requests.

Despite the extraordinarily challenging learning environment that was presented by the pandemic, we are pleased to report that there were still several matches made over this period that included both classroom visits (either one-time or recurring) across K-12 and participation in career awareness events at the middle and high school levels.

Moving forward, the STEAM Outreach Team will be seeking to build upon the incremental success of these past two years by increasing educator participation in our program and by expanding the list of available community resource volunteers. We will also continue to bring the message of the Foundation to the community at District events and through Foundation-sponsored activities, including support for our Career Exploration Fair when it returns to our event schedule in Spring 2023.

The EPSD Education Foundation events committee had another challenging year. Many of our annual events had to be canceled or postponed this year due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The events committee had to get creative! Fortunately, all was not lost. The Foundation was still able to create a few memorable events this year to celebrate STEAM-Powered education in East Penn.

Our 1st Annual EPSD Education Foundation Golf Outing was held on October 4, 2021 at Brookside Country Club. This first time event had 86 registered golfers! Golfers enjoyed a buffet breakfast, food truck snacks, lunch and complimentary beverages throughout the event with their round of golf. Our sponsorships raised approximately \$29,500 and our foursomes raised \$7,350. Our auction baskets and add-ons raised an additional \$3,070 leading to a grand total of \$39,920. After all expenses were paid, the Foundation earned a total of \$27,357 that will be used to fund many projects in the East Penn School District.
